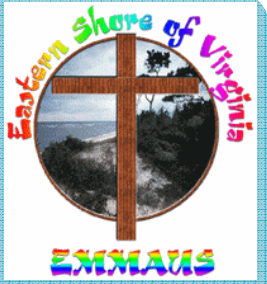

that you fill-out the applications completely and submit your fee with the applications.

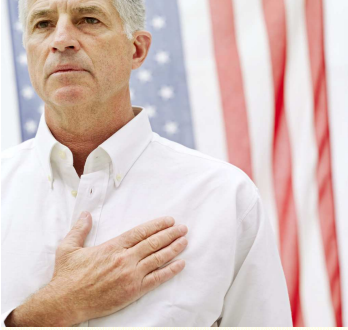
The next Board meeting with the held at 7pm at Woodberry UMC on July 26, 2010. All are welcome to attend.

Prayer Chain

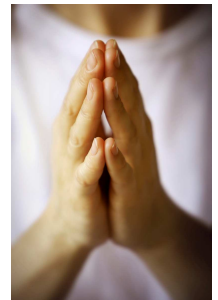

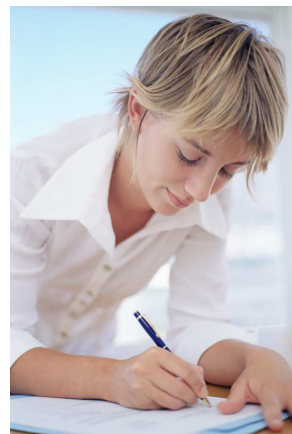
